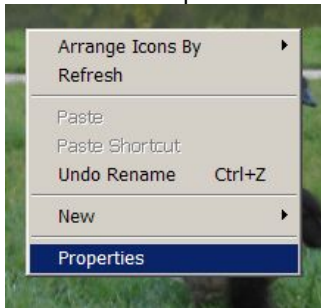
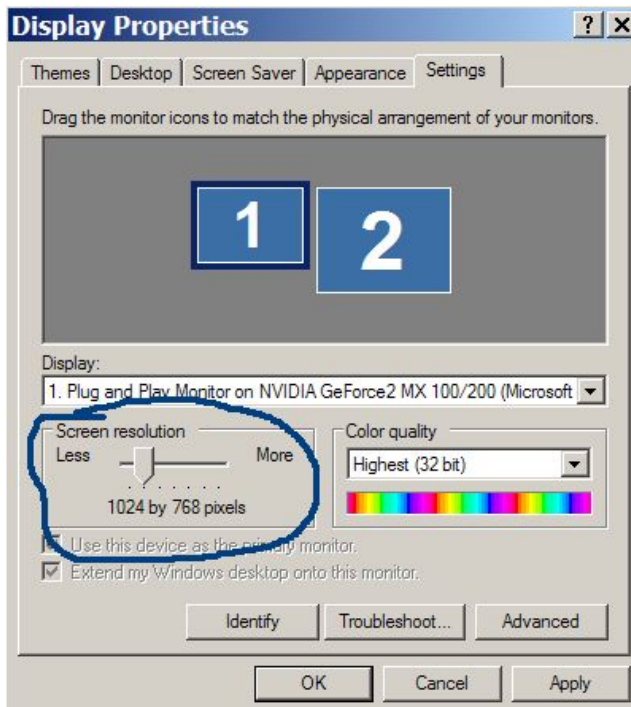


Setting the resolution to 1024 by 768 is quite easy. Here are the steps:

1. Right click your desktop
2. Choose "Properties"



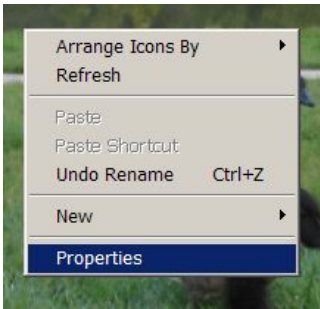
3. Click the "Settings" tab along the top of the window.
4. Move the slider in the lower left area of the window from 800x600 to 1024x768.



5. Press OK. It will change the resolution and ask to confirm. Press "Yes" if you can see the yes button. If your screen goes black it will change back to the original resolution within 15 seconds.

I know that many of you like things to be big on the screen. There is a way to make things larger while using 1024x768. The instructions for using "large fonts" are below.

1. Right click the desktop
2. Choose "Properties"



3. Click the Appearance tab.

4. Change the Font size choice at the bottom from normal to Large.

5. Press OK.

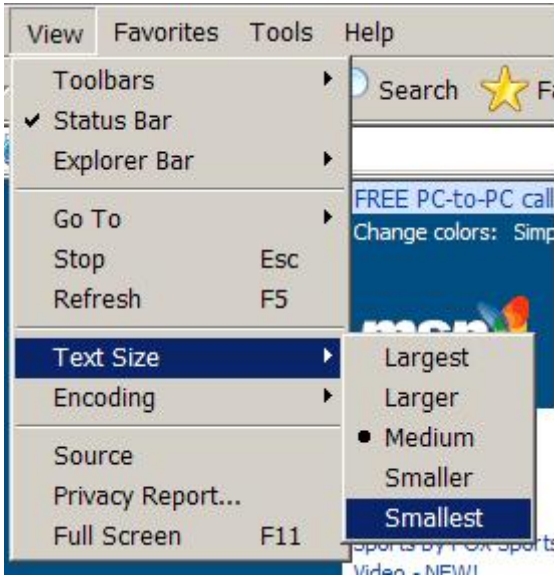
This will keep you from having to squint to see text on the higher resolution.

Internet Explorer Tips

Change the internet text size

1. In Internet Explorer click the View menu and choose Text Size.

2. Select Small or Smaller. This will allow more text to fit on the screen.



Notice that on the illustration above that there is a choice called "Full Screen." This will give you more room also. This mode can be toggled on and off by pressing F11.
